#### **Our Growth**

In December we moved our MYP and DP students into their new classrooms in the new wing of the building. The school now has the capacity to hold 400 students...quite an increase from our first year as a school with 12 students!

# Self-management Skills: Reflection and Feedback

The IB **approaches to learning skills** (ATL) are grounded in the belief that learning how to learn is fundamental to a student's life in and out of a school context. (Learning and Teaching, Primary Years Programme 2023 https://www.ibo.org/programmes/primary-years-programme/curriculum/learning-and-teaching/)


Our teachers reflected on the develoment of each **ATL skill** for each of their classes, to choose one of the skills to focus on as a whole school. From this data, **Self-management skills** were chosen. Following this, data collection began as a 'pre-assessment' to understand the perception of how our students have already developed their self-management skills, from a student perspective, a parent perspective and a teacher perspective. This data has informed the initiatives and activities planned by teachers to work further on the development of these skills.







# Spotlight on PYP Assessment



In the PYP assessment focuses on process not product. Our Early Learners have now completed 1 Unit of Inquiry, and our Elementary students have completed 2 Units of Inquiry. For these UOIs you will find observations and feedback from the teachers on your child's Managebac portfolio.

The portfolio also contains examples of the children's work, chosen to showcase the chid's learning journey.

Our students have now completed their first term **assessments** in Language and Maths. These assessments provide the opportunity for students to put their skills into practice under test conditions. These assessments lead to feedback and reflection from teacher, student and families. They then provide next steps and goals for the following term.

We have also issued our end of term **reports** which focus on the subject development along with ATL skills, the Learner profile and observations on the holistic development of the student. These reports are to supplement the PYP Managebac **portfolio**, the **comments** from parent - teacher meetings, and the UOI **feedback**.

All of these channels help our students and their families to have a better vision of how their learning journey is progressing.
